Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit

The Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit (HATC) is a credit for Manitoba homeowners and tenants. Property owners may have the credit directly applied to their municipal property tax statements. The Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit can only be claimed on a homeowner's principal residence up to a maximum of \$1500. The amount of the HATC is the lesser of \$1,500 and the gross school taxes on your principal residence. Applications received by April 1st will be added to the current tax year.
