CUTHBERT GRANT JR.

The First Leader of the Red River Métis



- Cuthbert Grant Jr. was born in 1793 in Fort de la Rivière Tremblante, SK. to Cuthbert Grant Sr., a prominent fur trader & partner in the North West Company, & Marguerite, a Cree woman. His career began as a clerk for the North West Company. Grant was a fur trader, Métis leader, farmer, medical practitioner, justice of the peace, & politician. He was known as a skillful negotiator & a peace maker. Grant had 3 wives & 13 children.
- In 1816, Grant led a force of 60 Métis in the Victory of Frog Plain (Battle of Seven Oaks) where they were fighting for their rights. Their victory set the stage for the birth of the Métis Nation.
- Grant was elected the leader of the Whitehorse Plain buffalo hunting brigades for many years, helping to establish the hunt's governance & rules.
- HBC's Governor Simpson gave Grant a tract of land on the White Horse Plain (23,000 acres), along the Assiniboine River, about 30 kilometers west of the Forks.
- In 1824, Grant's friends & family, as well as Métis buffalo hunters & their families from Pembina, North Dakota, joined him in creating the new settlement. There were about 100 families living in Grantown (named by settlers in honour of the founder). By 1849, over 900 people lived there. Grant gave each family head a river lot, 12 chains wide (792 feet) & 2 miles deep, running back from the river.
- Governor Simpson felt that Grantown was in an ideal location to warn the Red River Settlement of any advances being made from the west by Sioux warriors.
- Religious services were first held from 1824-28 in the home of Grant. In 1828 a log cabin was built, & in 1833 a new chapel called the St. François Xavier Roman Catholic Parish was built, lasting until the current structure was built in 1900. The parish is the 2nd oldest parish in Manitoba.
- In July 1828, the HBC appointed him as Warden of the Plains of Red River to prevent "the illicit trade in furs within that District."
- In 1829, Grant built a water-powered grist mill on Sturgeon Creek. Three years later, he abandoned the mill due to insufficient water flow & built a wind-powered mill in Grantown that operated for many years.
- In 1835 Grant was appointed as a councilor to the Council of Assiniboia, to represent the Métis.
- Grant died July 15, 1854, in St. François Xavier, after a fall from his horse. After his death, Grantown began to be called St. François Xavier to reflect the parish name. St. François Xavier was incorporated as a municipality in 1880.
- In 1972, the Government of Canada recognized him as a National Historic Person.
- The MMF named 2016 as the "Year of Cuthbert Grant Jr."
